Scoring: Items are scored 5, 4, 3, 2, or 1 corresponding to the

degree of agreement (strongly agree=5, agree=4,

neutral=3, disagree=2, or strongly disagree=1). Eight items were reverse scored; that is, strongly agree=1, agree=2, neutral=3, disagree=4, or strongly disagree=5). Reverse scored items are: 1, 6, 7, 8, 13, 18, 19, 20. To determine the subscale scores, we compute unweighted means of the items that load on each factor. Groupings are as follows:

Cognitive dimension

Items 3, 6, 9, 10, 12, 14, 16, 19, 20

Emotional dimension

Items 1, 2, 4, 5, 7, 8, 11, 13, 15, 17, 18
